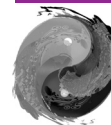

family support service

Providing support to families, friends and those affected by a loved one's substance misuse.

Services on offer within the Family Support Service include:

- Information about drugs and their effects
- General help and support with housing, legal, financial and benefit problems
- Information about other services and referral to them if necessary
- Alternative therapies to help individuals with relaxation, sleep problems and much more
- More informal, practical support including information sessions, advocacy and confidential chats
- Verbal advice and information supported by health education literature
- Home visits for families not able to attend the centre
- Provision of structured counselling, individual, couple or family
- A facilitator led support group with opportunity for ongoing support
- Access to respite
- Weekly day and evening drop in sessions
- Drugline Blackpool helpline - if you need to talk to someone out of hours
